of Sign Language Interpreting majors are employed in their field within a year of graduation.

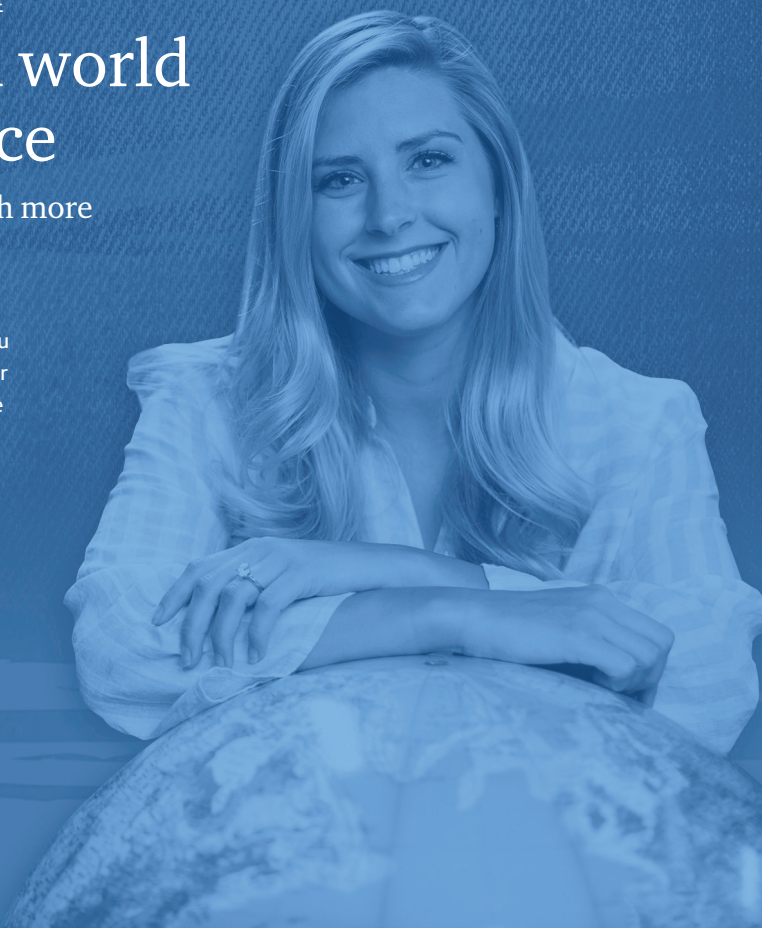

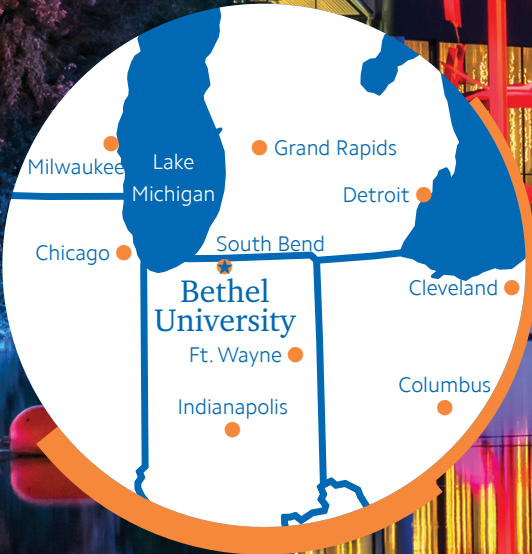
