

CLEP CREDIT

(College Level Examination Program)

Please be aware that traditional Bethel students may not obtain credit by CLEP examinations within the last 30 hours of a bachelor's degree or the last 18 hours of an associate's degree unless prior written approval has been granted through the academic dean. Contact the Registrar's Office (574.807.7410) for more information about the appeal process.

PRIOR TO REGISTERING AND PAYING FOR A CLEP TEST, please check with your Academic Advisor to confirm that you are eligible for the credits you may earn by taking the test.

REGISTERING: www.collegeboard.org/clep

- Click "CLEP Exams" at the top and look for the test you want to take.
- Choose where you want your scores sent.
- Make sure you are selecting "CLEP Test Center" as the Preferred Test Center (*DO NOT choose "Remote Proctoring" as we cannot proctor those tests.*)
- Pay CLEP Fee. (This does not include test center fee; see below.)
- Print out CLEP Exam Registration Ticket.

WHAT to bring on test day:

- CLEP Registration Ticket
- Government Issued Photo ID (i.e., Driver's license, passport, etc.)
- \$15.00 Test Center Fee – cash or check made out to Bethel University (no electronic payments)
 - ~ *We may not be able to make change. Please bring the exact amount.*

RESULTS: In most cases, you will receive results before you leave. Tests with a writing portion are graded by CLEP twice a month.

- The registrar's office receives an official transcript within 2-3 weeks.
- The registrar will evaluate results and grant credit as warranted. Notice of credit received will be sent to you.
